INSTRUCTIONS: This form should be used to determine whether a Domestic Relations Order (DRO) that has been submitted to HPOPS for determining whether such DRO is a Qualified Domestic Relations Order (QDRO). If any questions have an answer of "NO," the DRO is not a QDRO.

In accordance with §804.003 (f) and (g), Texas Government Code, and HPOPS Policy a DRO is a QDRO only if such order:

1. Clearly specifies the name, social security number, and last known mailing address, if any, of the member or retiree and the name, social security number, and mailing address of each Alternate Payee covered by the order; §804.003(f)(1). Social security number may be provided on a separate cover letter to HPOPS if not in the order.

2. Clearly specifies the amount or percentage of the member's or retiree's benefits to be paid by HPOPS to each Alternate Payee; §804.003(f)(2)

3. Clearly specifies the number of payments or the period to which such order applies; §804.003(f)(3)

5. Does not require HPOPS to provide any type or form of benefit or any option not otherwise provided under HPOPS governing statute, Article 6243g-4, Texas Revised Civil Statutes; §804.003(f)(5)

6. Does not require HPOPS to provide increased benefits determined on the basis of actuarial value; §804.003(f)(6)

7. Does not require the payment of benefits to an Alternate Payee which are required to be paid to another Alternate Payee under another order previously determined to be a qualified domestic relations order; §804.003(f)(7)

8. Does not require the payment of benefits to an Alternate Payee before the retirement of a Member, the distribution of a withdrawal of contributions to a Member, or other distribution to a Member required by law; §804.003(f)(8)

11. Does not require any action on the part of HPOPS contrary to its governing statute or plan provisions other than the direct payment of the benefit awarded to an Alternate Payee; §804.003(g)(5)

12. Does not make the award of an interest contingent on any condition other than those conditions resulting in the liability of a retirement system for payments under its plan provisions; §804.003(g)(6)
